

John Artis' 60th Anniversary Competition Official Rules

- 1) John Artis is running a competition to celebrate the 60th anniversary of its incorporation.
- 2) The competition is open to all eligible entrants from 1st August 2010 to 1st November 2010
- 3) There are ten prizes to be won. Each prize consists of six monogrammed champagne flutes and a bottle of champagne. Approximate retail value of each prize is £60.
- 4) The Prizes are non-transferable. There is no cash alternative or other substitutions of prizes by the winners. However, John Artis Limited reserves the right to substitute similar prizes of equal or greater value in the event the above prize is unavailable for any reason. The winners are solely responsible for all applicable government and local taxes with respect to the entire prize.
- 5) No purchase is necessary. Entry is limited to residents of the UK, who must be 18 years of age at the time the draw is made. There is also a link from the John Artis website to allow entrants to enter.

All entries must be received on or before 1st November 2010. The prize winners will be selected in a random draw conducted from all correct, valid entries on or about November 2nd 2010.
